The remaining balance can be paid by cash or cheque at Reception or by Parent Pay once you have activated your account and the Prices have been released by TFW.

We cannot guarantee passes will be ready for the first day of term for any applications received after 11 July.

You will be contacted by email about price changes and payment dates on a termly basis so please make sure you provide us with an email address. Prices can also be viewed on our website. You do not need to renew your application every term, we automatically order passes unless you inform us of any changes.

Collection of your ticket - Please bring with you a passport size photo which is needed for your season ticket and photo card as you are required to travel with both parts at all times.

Passes need to be collected within one week of the start of term. Uncollected train passes will be returned to Transport for Wales Rail Services thereafter and you will lose your £10 deposit.
